Sanction

This meet is approved by Michigan Swimming, Inc. (MS), as a timed final meet on behalf of USA Swimming (USA-S), Approved Meet Number MIAP2324024. In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Inc. and Michigan Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. MS rules, safety, and warm up procedures will govern the meet as if fully set forth in these meet rules.

Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy Acknowledgement

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. There will be at least two safety marshals at this competition, with at least one of each gender.

Facilities

Lake Orion High School is a 25-yard, 8-lane pool. Pool depth ranges from 8.5 - 14 feet at the start, and 3.5 - 14 feet at the turn. Permanent starting blocks, non-

turbulent lane markers, and Colorado timing system with an 8-lane display will be used. Three warm up lanes will be available during the meet. Ample balcony seating for spectators. Lockers are available (bring your own lock). The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4).

Course Certification

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

Meet Format

The meet will be run as a Timed Finals meet.

Eligibility

This meet is open to all swimmers meeting the YMCA membership requirements. The swimmer's age on December 1, 2023, will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group.

Entry Deadline

October 19, 2023 at 8pm

Entry Acceptance and Processing

Entries will be accepted and processed on a first come, first served basis in the order in which they are received after the entry open date listed above.

Individual Entry Limits

Swimmers may enter a maximum of **4 individual** events and **1 relay** event per day. Mixed relays (events 101, 103, 301, and 303) will have no gender requirements.

Entry Fees

\$5.00 per individual event and **\$20.00** for relays.

Surcharges

A **\$3.00** per athlete surcharge (including the \$1 Michigan Swimming athlete surcharge) applies.

Refunds

Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the Administrative Official there are no refunds in full or in part unless the "over qualification exception" applies (see MS Rules).

Check In

Check-in will not be required.

Marshaling

There will be marshalling on deck at this meet for the 8 & Under and 9-10 age groups. Swimmers will be responsible for reporting to the marshalling area when their event is called.

Seeding

The meet will be **pre-seeded** after entries are closed.

Deck Entries

Deck entries will be allowed. Deck entries to fill open lanes in the first heat only will be accepted by the Administrative Official until 15 minutes after the start of warmups for each session. New heats will not be added. Deck entries cost \$7.00 per individual event, or \$25.00 per relay event.

Declaration of Relay Swimmers

The names and order of all relay swimmers must be declared no later than 30 minutes following the start of warmups. This is done by BBD coaches.

Meet Programs/Admissions

Meet Programs: \$5.00 (Meet Program includes all Saturday and Sunday sessions)

Admissions: \$5.00 per day (12 & under with adult, free)

Scoring

No individual or team scoring will be kept.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded for all 12 & Under individual events, places 1-12. Ribbons will be awarded for places 1-6 for all 12 & Under relay events.

Results

Complete Official meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at http://www.miswim.org/.

Concessions

Concessions will be available for purchase. No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.

Lost and Found

Articles may be turned in/picked up at a designated area on the pool deck. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained at the Birmingham Family YMCA for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be at the sole discretion of the

Birmingham Family YMCA). The Birmingham Blue Dolphins and Lake Orion High School assume no responsibility for lost articles.

Swimming Safety

Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee which may include ejection from the meet.

Racing Start Certification

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Deck Personnel/Locker Rooms/Credentialing

Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck or in locker rooms. Access to the pool deck may only be granted to any other individual in the event of emergency through approval by the Meet Director or the Meet Referee. The Michigan Swimming Board of Directors, Officials Chairs of MS, and the Michigan Swimming Office staff are authorized deck personnel at all MS meets. Personal assistants/helpers of athletes with a disability shall be permitted when requested by an athlete with a disability or a coach of an athlete with a disability.

Lists of registered coaches, certified officials and meet personnel will be placed at the Volunteer Check-In Table in the upper level. Meet personnel will check the list of approved individuals and issue a credential to be displayed at all times during the meet. This credential will include the host team name as well as the function of the individual being granted access to the pool deck (Coach, Official, Timer, or Meet Personnel). In order to obtain a credential, Coaches and Officials must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet. Meet personnel must return the credential at the conclusion of working each day and be reissued a credential daily.

All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.

Swimmers with Disabilities

All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests, please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.

First Aid

Supplies will be kept in the Coaches Office/Computer Room on deck and will be available for use as needed.

Medical Supervision

Certified lifeguards will be available to athletes participating in this competition.

Facility Items

- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of any facility listed above.
- (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
- (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.
- (D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection from the Pool Director.
- (E) To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- (F) Deck changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes is **prohibited**.
- (G) Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

General Information and Errors/Omissions

Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the Meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.
